Overview. Like other professional healthcare regulators, we have a set of governing legislation. Our main legislation is the Nursing and Midwifery Order 2001 (' the Order '); a series of orders made by the Privy Council and Rules made by our Council sit underneath the Order. All our legislation was created under powers in the Health Act 1999, and all of our legislation is secondary legislation.
